A BILL

To reduce the pay of Members of Congress when a mass shooting occurs in the United States, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "No Pay Until Peace5 Act".

6 SEC. 2. REQUIRING WITHHOLDING OF PAY OF MEMBERS 7 OF CONGRESS IF MASS SHOOTING OCCURS.

8 (a) REDUCTION OF PAY.—If during any month of a9 year a mass shooting occurs in the United States, the an-

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nual rate of pay applicable under section 601(a) of the
 Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 4501)
 with respect to each Member of Congress for the year shall
 be reduced by an amount equal to the product of—

- 5 (1) an amount equal to one month's worth of6 pay under such annual rate; and
- 7 (2) the number of months during the year dur8 ing which a mass shooting occurs in the United
 9 States.

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall apply with
respect to days occurring after the date of the regularly
scheduled general election for Federal office held in November 2022.

14 SEC. 3. SPECIAL RULE FOR ONE HUNDRED SEVENTEENTH

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CONGRESS.

16 (a) IN GENERAL.—

(1) HOLDING SALARIES IN ESCROW.—If a mass
shooting occurs in the United States during a pay
period occurring during a session of the One Hundred Seventeenth Congress after the date of the enactment of this Act, the payroll administrator of
each House of Congress shall—

23 (A) deposit in an escrow account the com-24 pensation for such pay period of each Member

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of Congress who serves in that House of Congress; and

3 (B) release amounts deposited in an es4 crow account under subparagraph (A) to such
5 Member of Congress on the last day of the One
6 Hundred Seventeenth Congress.

7 (2)WITHHOLDING AND REMITTANCE \mathbf{OF} 8 AMOUNTS FROM PAYMENTS HELD IN ESCROW.—The 9 payroll administrator of each House of Congress 10 shall provide for the same withholding and remit-11 tance with respect to a payment deposited in an es-12 crow account under paragraph (1) that would apply 13 to the payment if the payment were not subject to 14 paragraph (1).

15 (3) Release of amounts at end of the 16 CONGRESS.—In order to ensure that this subsection 17 is carried out in a manner that shall not vary the 18 compensation of Senators or Representatives in vio-19 lation of the twenty-seventh amendment to the Con-20 stitution of the United States, the payroll adminis-21 trator of a House of Congress shall release for pay-22 ment to Members of that House of Congress any 23 amounts remaining in any escrow account under this 24 section on the last day of the One Hundred Seven-25 teenth Congress.

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(b) ROLE OF SECRETARY OF THE TREASURY.—The
 Secretary of the Treasury shall provide the payroll admin istrator of each House of Congress with such assistance
 as may be necessary to enable the payroll administrator
 to carry out this subtitle.

6 (c) EXCEPTION FOR DAYS OCCURRING AFTER GEN-7 ERAL ELECTION.—This section does not apply with re-8 spect to any pay period during the One Hundred Seven-9 teenth Congress which occurs after the date of the regu-10 larly scheduled general election for Federal office held in 11 November 2022.

12 (d) PAYROLL ADMINISTRATOR DEFINED.—In this
13 section, the term "payroll administrator", with respect to
14 a House of Congress, means—

(1) in the case of the House of Representatives,
the Chief Administrative Officer of the House of
Representatives, or an employee of the Office of the
Chief Administrative Officer who is designated by
the Chief Administrative Officer to carry out this
Act; and

(2) in the case of the Senate, the Secretary of
the Senate, or an employee of the Office of the Secretary of the Senate who is designated by the Secretary to carry out this Act.

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1 SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS.

2 In this Act—

3 (1) the term "mass shooting" means 4 or more
4 killings in a single incident by the use of a firearm
5 (as defined in section 921 of title 18, United States
6 Code); and

7 (2) the term "Member of Congress" means an
8 individual serving in a position under subparagraph
9 (A), (B), or (C) of section 601(a) of the Legislative
10 Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 4501).
